Day 1 – June 2021

Arrival at Edinburgh International Airport and group transfer to the hotel

Check In: **Waldorf Astoria Edinburgh - The Caledonian - 3 Nights – 5* - Deluxe Queen Rooms**

Built in 1903, Waldorf Astoria Edinburgh - the Caledonian is a historic icon in the heart of Edinburgh's Princes Street and offers views of Edinburgh Castle in the city.

The Waldorf Astoria Edinburgh - the Caledonian is within walking distance of Edinburgh Castle, the Royal Mile and the Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The hotel also features the only Guerlain Spa in the UK.

**Golf at North Berwick Golf Club with pull trollies (motorised carts not available)
Ranked 25th in the World**



North Berwick is the 13th oldest golf club in the world. Golf has been played over the historic West Links course since the 17th century, and we continue to play over the same piece of land as they did back then. With breath-taking views of the Firth of Forth and islands of Bass Rock, Craigeith, Lamb and Fidra, as well as the town of North Berwick itself, there are few places better in the world to play golf! A true championship links course, having hosted Final Qualifying for The Open Championship and both Gentlemen and Ladies Amateur Championships.

Day 3 – June 2021

**Golf at The Renaissance Club with pull trollies (motorised carts available with medical certificate)
Ranked 18th in Scotland**

Pre-round golf clinic with a Scottish Golf Professional to help with tips on playing Links courses in the wind.

The Renaissance Club nestles on 300 acres of the famous golfing coastline of the Firth of Forth. This club is the host of the Men's and Ladies Scottish Open's in 2019 and is a qualifying venue for The Open Championship.

Designed by acclaimed course architect Tom Doak, holes 9 to 11 connect the course to the coastline, and the par 4 10th is a dramatic highlight with its ribbon thin fairway and fiercely tilted green sitting tight along the edge of the cliffs, high above the Firth or Forth.



Day 4 – June 2021

Transfer to Gleneagles – Approx. 1hr drive

This morning, after a leisurely breakfast you will check out of your luxury accommodation at the Waldorf Astoria, and we will transfer by private coach to The Gleneagles Resort. On the way we will stop for a VIP Whiskey distillery tour. There are over 120 active distilleries spread across Scotland, which are split into five whisky-producing regions; Campbeltown, Highland, Islay, Lowland and Speyside. Where a whisky is made can have a huge bearing on its flavour, everything from the source of the water to the presence of peat in the local area will come through in the taste.

Host Venue of the 2014 Ryder Cup and 2019 Solheim Cup. The PGA® Centenary Course, created by Jack Nicklaus, is a modern classic. Even for a champion and acclaimed golf architect like Nicklaus, The PGA Centenary Course was a challenge. It had to be a truly great golf course, set as it is in the heart of Scotland, the country that gave the world golf. Thankfully Nicklaus described the course as "the finest parcel of land in the world I have ever been given to work with". The key to scoring well on the PGA Centenary is to avoid coming up short with your approach shots.

Day 6 – June 2021

Golf at Gleneagles Kings Course with pull trolleys (motorised carts available with medical certificate)

Ranked 16th in Scotland



The King's Course opened in 1919, and was the Host of the first informal Ryder Cup match between Britain and the USA. James Braid's plan for the King's Course was to test even the best players' shot-making skills over the eighteen holes. You find out all about it with your first approach shot. If you have driven straight and long from the tee, you will have what looks like a simple pitch to the elevated green. But you must be sure to select the correct club, because the shot is always a little longer than you think, with the wind over the putting surface often stronger than you can feel it from the fairway...and if you do not make the severely sloping green, a bunker yawns twenty feet below. Selecting the right club for each approach shot is the secret on the King's. It is certainly one of the most beautiful and exhilarating places to play golf in the world, with the springy moorland turf underfoot, the sweeping views from the tees all around, the rock-faced mountains to the north, the green hills to the south, and the peaks of the Trossachs and Ben Vorlich on the western horizon.

Day 7 – June 2021

Transfer to St Andrews – Approx. 1.5hr drive

This morning you will check out of your luxury accommodation at The Renaissance, and we will transfer by private coach to St Andrews. On the way we will stop for Scottish Castle visit. One of the best things about Scotland is that no matter where you find yourself, a castle is never far away.

Check In **Old Course Hotel** – 5 nights – 5* - Eden Rooms

Bordering the renowned 17th Road Hole of the Old Course, the Old Course Hotel overlooks the famous links courses and the West Sands Beach. This prestigious Five Star hotel is recognised as one of Europe's leading resorts. The hotel offers fine dining in the Road Hole Restaurant, and light, informal dining in the Sands Grill. Alternatively, the hotel's own golfing pub, the Jigger Inn, serves real ale and traditional food. The Kohler Waters Spa facilities include a swimming pool, whirlpool, sauna and steam rooms, weights and fitness rooms. The town centre is only a short walk from the hotel.

**Golf at Carnoustie Golf Links with pull trollies (motorised carts only available to disabled golfers with medical certificate)
Ranked 21st in the World**

Carnoustie Golf Links is an iconic, world-leading golf destination in Scotland and home to 'Golf's Greatest Test'. Golf has been played at the Links since the 16th century and it was Carnoustie natives who went on to establish the Professional Golfer's Associations of America and Australia. The Championship Course played host to The 147th Open, with Francesco Molinari becoming the 2018 Champion Golfer of the Year.

Walking Tour of St Andrews with a local guide

St Andrews is an affluent town with a coastal setting and picturesque cobbled streets lined with medieval ruins, gray-stoned university buildings and the world's most famous golf course. There is so much to discover in here, so today we will be taking a guided walking tour through its streets with a local expert to give us a fuller insight into St Andrew's long history, architectural treasures and regal residents.

The oldest 'new' course in the world, the second course at the Home of Golf was built by the Keeper of the Green Tom Morris in 1895 and it was imaginatively named to differentiate from its famous neighbour. Boasting undulating fairways and challenging greens, the New Course is a classic test of Links golf. The construction of the New Course was paid for by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club. The result is a classic links course which is a first-class golfing challenge. The course has the traditional out and back layout, with the 18th green just to the right of the first tee.



Pricing

Every effort is made to ensure that the prices quoted to you are correct; however, Golf & Tours Pty Ltd acts only as an agent and relies on information provided to us from our suppliers of the travel services and products listed in this itinerary. We will bring to your attention any change in price prior to you paying the balance of the tour. N.B some golf clubs, hotels, transfer companies and travel service providers reserve the right to increase their pricing due to increases in green fees, hotel accommodation charges and currency fluctuations etc. Where the increase in price is greater than 10% of the original price of the tour, you may choose to either:

Termination of Booking Contract or Change of Travel Arrangements due to Force Majeure

If Golf & Tours in its reasonable opinion, considers that any Force Majeure event prevents Golf & Tours (whether directly or through its employees, contractors, subcontractors and agents) from lawfully or safely providing any products or services subject of the booking contract with you, Golf & Tours may immediately by written notice: (a) terminate the booking contract (in whole or in part); or

(b) change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice you for any additional costs.

Limitation of Liability in the Event of Force Majeure
