
Day 1 Monday 9 September 2024

Group Airport Transfer

Arrival at Bordeaux Airport and transfer to the hotel

Overnight at **Renaissance Bordeaux Hotel** - Standard Room

In the trendy Bacalan neighborhood in the heart of Bordeaux' harbour vibrant district, this elegant, upscale hotel is a 4-minute walk from Cité du Vin, a wine museum, 5 minutes away by foot from a tram stop and 5 km from the Bordeaux Cathedral. The warm, refined rooms provide flat-screen TVs, Wi-Fi and kettles. An indoor pool overlooks the city. A polished restaurant serves Italian cuisine and features a terrace. Other amenities include a contemporary cocktail bar on the rooftop, which is the perfect spot to watch the sunset.

Golf du Médoc - Les Châteaux Course - 18 Holes of Golf with shared motorised carts

The Châteaux course was voted Best Course in France in 2014, 2016, 2017 and 2018 by the World Golf Awards. It is currently ranked #9 in France. Bill Coore's design respects the tradition of Scottish links with its wide fairways lined with heather, gorse and broom. One of the best holes is the 11th, where a stream crosses the fairway, then runs all the way up the left to the rear of the green, punishing both stray drives and wayward approach shots.

Day 3 Wednesday 11 September 2024

Free time to explore Bordeaux

This morning, spend time exploring the gorgeous UNESCO listed city of Bordeaux. The city is filled with classical and neoclassical architecture and is home to more than 350 structures that are nationally or regionally listed Historical Monuments (Monuments Historiques). Le Miroir d'Eau – the water mirror, is facing the Place de la Bourse, and a beautiful marvel, worthy of a photo or two.

Port de la Lune (Port of the Moon) is the nickname given to the crescent-shaped Port of Bordeaux along the Garonne River. Stretching from the Quai de Bacalan to the Quai de Paludate in the centre of the city, the Port of the Moon incorporates the Place de la Bourse and the Quays Market. Lined with quaint boutiques, chic bars and restaurants, it's a beautiful and classy area to wander around.



Afternoon visit to a Bordeaux château and winery with wine-tasting

A trip to Bordeaux would not be complete without a visit and tasting at a Bordeaux winery. This world-famous wine region is home to some of the oldest and most prestigious wineries in the world. The designated red grape varieties in Bordeaux are Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Carmenere. Wines from this region set a benchmark for winemakers around the world.

You'll enjoy a full tour of the vineyards and the château, including the cellars. This tour is followed by a wine-tasting, where you will sample different vintages and varietals, all paired with local cheeses. À votre santé!

Grand Saint Emilionnais Golf Club - 18 Holes of Golf with shared motorised carts

This exceptional course unfolds in a valley fringed by centenary oak trees, framed by vineyards and located just 6 miles from the village of Saint Emilion, a Unesco world heritage site. Currently ranked #22 in France, this Tom Doak's designed course unfolds in a valley fringed by centenary oak trees and framed by vineyards. Its undulating greens and fairways, follow the natural contours of the land, giving each hole its unique challenge.



Visit to the medieval village of Saint-Émilion

After golf today, two thousand years of history awaits you on your visit to the picturesque, medieval village of Saint-Émilion. You'll have free time to explore this picturesque, world heritage listed medieval village. Every square in the small village centre is packed with history and some incredible architecture. Thousands of hectares of vines surround the medieval village making the landscape an unforgettable scenery.

Visit to the beautiful town of Cognac

With its impressive architecture, delicious restaurants and remarkably nice people, there will be time for you to stroll the narrow paved streets of the city centre to absorb the charm of Vieux Cognac (the old Cognac). With almost 200 Cognac producers in the area, we will be enjoying a tasting at one of the region's top cognac houses, which will include a tour of the distillery and vats.


Overnight at Hôtel Le Clos d'Amboise - Standard Room

This is a sumptuous 17th century house converted into a charming hotel in 2003 and upgraded into a 20 room, luxury hotel in 2011, while retaining its character. Everything which speaks of the house's history and gives it its character has been conserved: the floor of the reception hall with its cabochon tiling, the staircase serving the upper floors, and the magnificent 18th century Versailles oak parquet in two salons. Hotel Le Clos d'Amboise is located in the very heart of the Royal City of Amboise, in the picturesque historic part of the city that contains France's first chateau, and Leonardo da Vinci's residence, the Clos Lucé.

Les Aisses Golf - 18 Holes of Golf with shared motorised carts

Like the crisp, bright wines for which the Loire Valley is famous, Les Aisses has a distinctive character. Currently ranked #8 in France, this is a truly striking golf course which has been cut out of ancient woodland to provide large fairways and generous greens. The combination of its bold bunkering with the wispy heather is phenomenal. The variety is admirable, with some standout holes that linger in your memory. The holes meander amidst the moors, ponds and woods which make the courses varied, enjoyable and challenging.



Overnight at **Hôtel Le Littré** - Classic Room

In the 6th arrondissement, this truly Parisian, family-run 1920s hotel is poised between the vibrant realms of St Germain des Prés and Montparnasse, and has been managed by the same family for three generations. This district is a Parisienne favourite for its atmosphere and classy shopping.

The hotel is within a 7-minute walk of the Notre-Dame-des-Champs metro station, and a 12-minute walk from the Luxembourg Gardens. The rooms, overlooking the hotel's inner courtyard, and promise absolute peace and quiet. High-quality bedding and cozy comforters ensure a peaceful night's sleep.

Whether in the cosy bar, the garden or in your room, this will be the perfect base for our stay in Paris.

Currently ranked #3 in France, the holes on the Vineuil Course are generally set well back from the surrounding forest, and routed across a gently undulating pasture with attractive fairways lined by waving fescues.

Travel Insurance

Pricing

Every effort is made to ensure that the prices quoted to you are correct; however, Golf & Tours Pty Ltd acts only as an agent and relies on information provided to us from our suppliers of the travel services and products listed in this itinerary. We will bring to your attention any change in price prior to you paying the balance of the tour. N.B some golf clubs, hotels, transfer companies and travel service providers reserve the right to increase their pricing due to increases in green fees, hotel accommodation charges and currency fluctuations etc. Where the increase in price is greater than 10% of the original price of the tour, you may choose to either:

- (a) cancel the applicable booking without incurring any penalty; or
- (b) accept the change of price

You must notify the Golf & Tours of your choice within 14 days of receipt of notice of the increase or you will be deemed to have accepted the price change and will be liable for payment of the increase.

Payments

Golf & Tours accepts the following payment methods: Direct bank deposits, cheque and credit card (Visa, American Express or MasterCard N.B credit card payments will incur a 2.9% processing fee).

A \$2,000pp deposit is required to secure your place on this tour. After you have confirmed your booking we will contact you so you can make this payment.

One week prior to the balance due date, 11th June 2024, Golf & Tours will contact you, advising of the full amount owing for the tour, minus the deposit already paid, giving you the final balance owing. If you wish to make this final balance payment earlier than this date, please contact Golf & Tours Pty Ltd.

Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellations by the client must be in writing and are subject to the following forfeit of cost per person:

- Cancellation before final balance payment is required: Deposit lost
- Cancellation after final balance payment has been completed: 100% of the tour cost charged

If the company is forced to cancel a tour due to minimum numbers not being reached, a full refund or option to transfer full deposit to a subsequent tour will be offered to the client. This does not include Force Majeure.

Force Majeure

Force Majeure means the occurrence of an event that is beyond Golf & Tours' reasonable control and which could not have been reasonably prevented by Golf & Tours which includes, but is not limited to: (a) war, armed conflict, criminal damage, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity or the threat of any such acts; (b) natural disaster (including but not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide, pandemic), adverse weather conditions, high or low water levels; (c) nuclear or other industrial accident causing environmental pollution or contamination; or (d) change in law, meaning, enactment, amendment (including repeal) in the law or administration of any law in Australia or any jurisdiction or territory relevant to the booking contract, which includes changes in statute, regulation, determination, by-law, declaration, licence and the common law as applicable from time to time.

Termination of Booking Contract or Change of Travel Arrangements due to Force Majeure

If Golf & Tours in its reasonable opinion, considers that any Force Majeure event prevents Golf & Tours (whether directly or through its employees, contractors, subcontractors and agents) from lawfully or safely providing any products or services subject of the booking contract with you, Golf & Tours may immediately by written notice: (a) terminate the booking contract (in whole or in part); or (b) change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice you for any additional costs.

Limitation of Liability in the Event of Force Majeure

In the event of a force majeure event making it impossible or unsafe for Golf & Tours to deliver all or part of the Tour Package, Golf & Tours reserves the rights to postpone the tour to new dates. If these rescheduled dates do not suit the client, Golf & Tours will offer a credit voucher to the full value they have paid for the postponed trip, to be used on a future tour (within 12 months of original tours departure date). Or at Golf & Tours discretion, refund the customer for the unperformed part of the Tour Package less any reasonable losses incurred by cancellation. Losses may amount to a substantial proportion of the tour package price. Golf & Tours will use reasonable endeavours to minimise losses incurred by customers.
