The challenging, Robert Trent Jones Sr designed par-72 Blue Course spanning 6,205 meters, is a regular host of the prestigious Moroccan Open. Prepare to navigate the fairways, lined with majestic trees and strategically placed bunkers. The course boasts a fabulous set of par 3's, while two expansive lakes come into play on multiple holes, adding an extra layer of challenge and beauty to this exceptional golfing experience.

Royal Golf Dar Es Salam - Red Course - 18 Holes with Pull Buggy *Motorised carts available for those golfers with a medical certificate* **Ranked #1 in Morocco**

Morocco's King Hassan II – a real golf enthusiast – commissioned American-based architect Robert Trent Jones to design Royal Golf Dar Es Salam in the late 1960s on a massive 1,000-acre site. This is literally a course fit for royalty. The tingle of anticipation, which every true golfer feels on approaching a course, begins at Rabat with a salute from the guard at the imposing mosaic gatehouse. Apart from the customary splashed bunkers, doglegged fairways and raised greens to be found on most of his layouts, he also shipped in some Roman column ruins – found between holes 11 and 12 – from the ancient city of Volubilis. The signature hole on the property is undoubtedly the par three 9th where the tee shot has to carry a lily pond, complete with wading flamingos, to a shallow island green surrounded by flowers and trees – definitely one for the camera.



After Golf

Half Day Guided Rabat City Tour

Discover the captivating city of Rabat, Morocco's capital, renowned for its historical landmarks, exquisite architecture, and vibrant culture. Join a guided city tour to delve into the rich heritage and charm of the UNESCO recognised imperial city of Rabat.





Two of Rabat's most significant historical sites, the 12th century Hassan Tower and Mohammed V Mausoleum, sit next to each other at one of the highest points of the city. The never-completed tower was intended to be the tallest minaret in the world. Even at a modest 44 meters it's still an imposing sight, which has been watching over the city for eight centuries. The adjacent white marble mausoleum, with red-uniformed royal guards on each of the four entrances, contains the tombs of the Moroccan king Mohammed V and his two sons. This monument is more than a burial site; it is a tribute to Arabic-Islamic art that showcases all the charms of this heritage.

Perched above the sea and the river, the Kasbah of the Udayas, is Rabat's historic citadel, and another a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A haven of tranquillity, with its flower-filled little streets, Andalusian garden, and Moorish café, the Kasbah of the Udayas is one of the most unique and beautiful sites in Morocco.

We'll also venture into the bustling heart of Rabat—the Medina, a labyrinth of narrow lanes teeming with shops, vendors, and colourful markets. We'll immerse ourselves in the vibrant tapestry of daily life in Rabat, soak in the bustling atmosphere, and browse for souvenirs, spices, and traditional handicrafts amidst the lively ambiance of the Medina. A truly authentic Moroccan experience.

The course winds its way through the natural Argan vegetation, gradually building up to a thrilling climax on the last three holes (a par four then a short par three followed by a par five) which are played out along the edge of an impressive 80-metre cliff. These final holes are sure to exhilarate, creating unforgettable moments and endless tales to share while relaxing on the terrace of the magnificent clubhouse.



Assoufid Golf Club - 18 Holes with Shared Motorised Cart Ranked #5 in Morocco

Nestled amidst the picturesque setting of the snow-capped Atlas Mountains, Assoufid Golf Club features a, par-72 course that winds through a distinctive desert landscape with natural undulations. The par four 5th is one of the toughest holes on the card. Played from an elevated tee, its fairway is flanked on either side by desert as it rises directly towards the Atlas Mountains. The tee for the par three 17th is located at the highest point on the course – offering panoramic views of all the holes on the back nine – and it's the starting point for the signature hole at Assoufid. Tee shots must carry a natural dry stream (called a shaaba) that runs through the course before reaching a wide but shallow green protected by bunkers to the front and rear.

Flights

This tour requires a minimum number of golfers to proceed. Please do not book your flights until you have been advised by Golf & Tours that this tour will be proceeding. If minimum numbers are not achieved, you will be offered a full refund or opportunity to transfer your payment to another tour.

Revisions, Modifications & Pre/Post Tour Options

Once Golf & Tours has confirmed that the minimum number of guests for a tour has been met, guests are kindly asked to decide if they would like Golf & Tours to arrange extra nights of accommodation before or after the tour, and if their flight schedules do not match the group airport transfers, whether they would prefer a private airport transfer. Golf & Tours is more than willing to organize these additional arrangements for our guests at no extra charge, up until the final balance due date. Any changes made to bookings after this date will incur a \$100 service fee.



Passport & Visas

It is your sole responsibility to ensure you have a valid passport at the time of travelling and that you hold all necessary visas and permits required by the country/countries you will be travelling to. All travellers must hold a passport for international travel, with at least 6 months validity.

Travel Insurance

It is mandatory that you have your own comprehensive travel insurance while travelling on a Golf & Tours holiday. The policy should provide cover for any element of your booking including loss of deposit, cancellation, liability for illness, medical expenses, repatriation, personal injury, death or loss of any kind, delay and inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by Golf & Tours or by any other third parties we subcontract to, and loss or damage to baggage and valuables. You are responsible for making any special or increased insurance arrangements which you deem are necessary. The payments made to G&T for your tour are non-refundable. Travel insurance will cover you for unseen circumstances that may force you to withdraw from the tour. Golf & Tours strongly recommends that you take out "Cancel for Any Reason" (CFAR) insurance.

Travel Health

Getting sick overseas is a sure way to ruin your trip. Taking appropriate precautions before beginning your trip can reduce your risk of getting sick whilst overseas. Prevention is better than cure. Your GP or travel doctor can tell you exactly what vaccinations you need for your upcoming trip. Their advice considers your health, your immunisation history and your destination. Golf & Tours recommends speaking to your doctor, and to consider vaccinating yourself, or getting a booster to protect yourself, against COVID-19 and Influenza.

Staying hydrated is essential when travelling. Worldwide, tap water varies from country to country. Drinking water in other countries is one of the leading causes of health issues for travellers. Travellers become ill because the water pathogens in the local tap water are foreign to their immune systems. At the same time, locals can drink from the same source and have no issue whatsoever because they have adapted to the water supply from a very early age. Golf & Tours recommends drinking bottle water, and using bottled water to brush your teeth on any tour, outside of your home country.

Pricing

Every effort is made to ensure that the prices quoted to you are correct; however, Golf & Tours Pty Ltd acts only as an agent and relies on information provided to us from our suppliers of the travel services and products listed in this itinerary. We will bring to your attention any change in price prior to you paying the balance of the tour. N.B some golf clubs, hotels, transfer companies and travel service providers reserve the right to increase their pricing due to increases in green fees, hotel accommodation charges



and currency fluctuations etc. Where the increase in price is greater than 10% of the original price of the tour, you may choose to either:

- (a) cancel the applicable booking without incurring any penalty; or
- (b) accept the change of price

You must notify the Golf & Tours of your choice within 14 days of receipt of notice of the increase or you will be deemed to have accepted the price change and will be liable for payment of the increase.

Payments

Golf & Tours accepts the following payment methods: Direct bank deposits, Wire Transfers and Credit Cards (Visa, American Express or MasterCard N.B credit card payments will incur a 3.9% processing fee for all international cards and a 2.9% processing fee for Australian cards).

A **EUR3,000pp deposit** is required to secure your place on this tour. After you have confirmed your booking, we will contact you so you can make this payment.

This tour has been priced in Euro (EUR). At the time of booking, you will be able to choose the currency that you wish to make all of your payments in. The deposit amount below, will be in your chosen currency. Eg. If you chose USD, your deposit will be USD3,000pp & the balance in USD. If you chose AUD as your chosen currency, your deposit will be AUD3,000pp & the balance in AUD.

One week prior to the balance due date, **19th August 2025**, Golf & Tours will contact you, advising of the full amount owing for the tour, minus the deposit already paid, giving you the final balance owing. Cancellations & Refunds

Force Majeure means the occurrence of an event that is beyond Golf & Tours' reasonable control and which could not have been reasonably prevented by Golf & Tours which includes, but is not limited to: (a) war, armed conflict, criminal damage, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity or the threat of any such acts; (b) natural disaster (including but not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide,



pandemic), adverse weather conditions, high or low water levels; (c) nuclear or other industrial accident causing environmental pollution or contamination; or (d) change in law, meaning, enactment, amendment (including repeal) in the law or administration of any law in Australia or any jurisdiction or territory relevant to the booking contract, which includes changes in statute, regulation, determination, by-law, declaration, licence and the common law as applicable from time to time.

Termination of Booking Contract or Change of Travel Arrangements due to Force Majeure

If Golf & Tours in its reasonable opinion, considers that any Force Majeure event prevents Golf & Tours (whether directly or through its employees, contractors, subcontractors and agents) from lawfully or safely providing any products or services subject of the booking contract with you, Golf & Tours may immediately by written notice: (a) terminate the booking contract (in whole or in part); or (b) change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice you for any additional costs.

Limitation of Liability in the Event of Force Majeure

In the event of a force majeure event making it impossible or unsafe for Golf & Tours to deliver all or part of the Tour Package, Golf & Tours reserves the rights to postpone the tour to new dates. If these rescheduled dates do not suit the client, Golf & Tours will offer a credit voucher to the full value they have paid for the postponed trip, to be used on a future tour (within 12 months of original tours departure date). Or at Golf & Tours discretion, refund the customer for the unperformed part of the Tour Package less any reasonable losses incurred by cancellation. Losses may amount to a substantial proportion of the tour package price. Golf & Tours will use reasonable endeavours to minimise losses incurred by customers. Customers must take out travel insurance to protect themselves against loss in these circumstances.
