
#### Day 1 Monday 1 September 2025

In recent years Campo de Ourique has started to make a name for itself as a foodie destination in Lisbon, with new and innovative restaurants opening up and thriving. Throughout the food and culture walk, you will be taken on a foodie journey through the local food market and other traditional restaurants and hidden gems where locals eat.

The fescue feast of Dunas plays like a links course and sits 1km from the Atlantic Ocean. The holes are routed along wide fairways lined by corridors of mature trees, where playability off the tee is paramount – with sandy waste areas populated with some native vegetation – you need strategy on every tee shot. There is always a better side of the fairway to approach the green from and sometimes dramatic reward for a bold line.



#### Non-Golfers Tour of Comporta 'The Hamptons of Europe'

Today, after the golfers are dropped off for golf at Dunas, our non-golfers will enjoy a tour of Comporta, one of Portugal's trendiest and most exclusive resort towns. Renowned for its unspoiled natural beauty and miles of pristine beaches, this coastal town is home to a mix of artists and A listers. The environment has been preserved for



years, in part thanks to its status as a highly protected nature reserve (look out for huge nesting storks and flamingos in the river), in addition to previously being owned by the Espírito Santo banking family (Portugal's leading banking group), which closely oversaw any development. Days here are unhurried. It's an easy, breezy stylish existence in this part of Portugal, with comparisons to New York's Hamptons. Comporta is a small village in size, but it is full of sophisticated restaurants, tastefully designed stores and chic hotels.

Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Royal Alcázar of Seville is the oldest royal palace in Europe that is still in use today. It dates back to the 11th century, when the Muslim authorities decided to build a fortress in a strategic location to protect the city. The grounds of the Royal Alcázar are made up of various palaces and gardens that were designed in different historical periods, making its architecture so varied. It combines Islamic, Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, and Romantic elements, as well as some of the finest examples of Mudéjar art, which is the product of both Islamic and Christian cultures. The stunning gardens of the Real Alcázar Palace make up one of the great palace sites of the Spanish crown, and possibly the oldest.


#### Non-Golfers Visit to the Alcazaba de Málaga and Picasso Museum in Málaga

Today our non-golfers will enjoy a tour to Malaga. First stop is the Alcazaba de Málaga, which is considered one of Spain's most beautiful. This fortified palace was built on the slopes of the Gibralfaro mountain where there were already some Phoenician-Punic remains. This position was a very strategic defence point of the city. The Alcazaba was constructed by the Muslims during their occupation of the Iberian Peninsula during the Middle Ages.

Málaga is also the birth place of Pablo Picasso. The Museo Picasso Málaga tells the story of Picasso's career, with two floors of galleries around a pretty marble courtyard. The permanent exhibition comprises a selection of pieces from the private collections of two



relatives, Christine Ruiz-Picasso and Bernard Ruiz-Picasso. More than 200 works cover the different styles, materials and techniques used by the Spanish artist.

If, due to Force Majeure event making it impossible or unsafe for Golf & Tours to deliver all or part of the Tour Package, Golf & Tours reserved the rights to postpone the tour to new dates.

#### Flights

This tour requires a minimum number of golfers to proceed. Please do not book your flights until you have been advised by Golf & Tours that this tour will be proceeding. If minimum numbers are not achieved, you will be offered a full refund or opportunity to transfer your payment to another tour.

#### **Revisions, Modifications & Pre/Post Tour Options**

Once Golf & Tours has confirmed that the minimum number of guests for a tour has been met, guests are kindly asked to decide if they would like Golf & Tours to arrange extra nights of accommodation before or after the tour, and if their flight schedules do not match the group airport transfers, whether they would prefer a private airport transfer. Golf & Tours is more than willing to organize these additional arrangements for our guests at no extra charge, up until the final balance due date. Any changes made to bookings after this date will incur a \$100 service fee.



#### **Passport & Visas**

It is your sole responsibility to ensure you have a valid passport at the time of travelling and that you hold all necessary visas and permits required by the country/countries you will be travelling to. All travellers must hold a passport for international travel, with at least 6 months validity.

<u>As of 2025</u>, the rules of travel to most European countries change. Starting in the first half of 2025, people from over 60 visa-exempt countries are required to have a travel authorisation to enter 30 European countries for a short stay.

ETIAS travel authorisation is an entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of these 30 European countries. It is linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to three years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new ETIAS travel authorisation.

With a valid ETIAS travel authorisation, you can enter the territory of these European countries as often as you want for short-term stays - normally for up to 90 days in any 180-day period.

From 2025, you can fill out the application form using either via the official ETIAS website or the ETIAS mobile application. Applying for the ETIAS travel authorisation costs EUR 7, though some travellers are exempt from paying this fee.

#### **Travel Insurance**

It is mandatory that you have your own comprehensive travel insurance while travelling on a Golf & Tours holiday. The policy should provide cover for any element of your booking including loss of deposit, cancellation, liability for illness, medical expenses, repatriation, personal injury, death or loss of any kind, delay and inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by Golf & Tours or by any other third parties we subcontract to, and loss or damage to baggage and valuables. You are responsible for making any special or increased insurance arrangements which you deem are necessary. The payments made to G&T for your tour are non-refundable. Travel insurance will cover you for unseen circumstances that may force you to withdraw from the tour. Golf & Tours strongly recommends that you take out "Cancel For Any Reason" (CFAR) insurance.

#### **Travel Health**

Getting sick overseas is a sure way to ruin your trip. Taking appropriate precautions before beginning your trip can reduce your risk of getting sick whilst overseas. Prevention is better than cure. Your GP or travel doctor can tell you exactly what vaccinations you need for your upcoming trip. Their advice considers your health, your immunisation history and your destination. Golf & Tours recommends speaking to your doctor, and to consider vaccinating yourself, or getting a booster to protect yourself, against COVID-19 and Influenza.



Staying hydrated is essential when travelling. Worldwide, tap water varies from country to country. Drinking water in other countries is one of the leading causes of health issues for travellers. Travellers become ill because the water pathogens in the local tap water are foreign to their immune systems. At the same time, locals can drink from the same source and have no issue whatsoever because they have adapted to the water supply from a very early age. Golf & Tours recommends drinking bottle water, and using bottled water to brush your teeth on any tour, outside of your home country.

#### Pricing

Every effort is made to ensure that the prices quoted to you are correct; however, Golf & Tours Pty Ltd acts only as an agent and relies on information provided to us from our suppliers of the travel services and products listed in this itinerary. We will bring to your attention any change in price prior to you paying the balance of the tour. N.B some golf clubs, hotels, transfer companies and travel service providers reserve the right to increase their pricing due to increases in green fees, hotel accommodation charges and currency fluctuations etc. Where the increase in price is greater than 10% of the original price of the tour, you may choose to either:

- (a) cancel the applicable booking without incurring any penalty; or
- (b) accept the change of price

You must notify the Golf & Tours of your choice within 14 days of receipt of notice of the increase or you will be deemed to have accepted the price change and will be liable for payment of the increase.

#### Payments

Golf & Tours accepts the following payment methods: Direct bank deposits, Wire Transfers and Credit Cards (Visa, American Express or MasterCard N.B credit card payments will incur a 2.9% processing fee for Australian Cards and a 3.9% processing fee for any non-Australian Credit Cards.

A **30% per person deposit** is required to secure your place on this tour. After you have confirmed your booking, we will contact you so you can make this payment.

A further 30% per person progress payment will be due 180 days prior to the tour date with the final balance due on **3<sup>rd</sup> June 2025**. Golf & Tours will contact you, advising of the full amount owing for the tour, minus the deposits already paid, giving you the final balance owing.

This tour has been priced in Euro (EUR). At the time of booking, you will be able to choose the currency that you wish to make all of your payments in.

#### **Cancellations & Refunds**

Cancellations by the client must be in writing and are subject to the following forfeit of cost per person:

• Cancellation before final balance payment is required: Deposit lost



• Cancellation after final balance payment has been completed: 100% of the tour cost charged

If the company is forced to cancel a tour due to minimum numbers not being reached, a full refund or option to transfer full deposit to a subsequent tour will be offered to the client. This does not include Force Majeure.

#### **Force Majeure**

Force Majeure means the occurrence of an event that is beyond Golf & Tours' reasonable control and which could not have been reasonably prevented by Golf & Tours which includes, but is not limited to: (a) war, armed conflict, criminal damage, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity or the threat of any such acts; (b) natural disaster (including but not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide, pandemic), adverse weather conditions, high or low water levels; (c) nuclear or other industrial accident causing environmental pollution or contamination; or (d) change in law, meaning, enactment, amendment (including repeal) in the law or administration of any law in Australia or any jurisdiction or territory relevant to the booking contract, which includes changes in statute, regulation, determination, by-law, declaration, licence and the common law as applicable from time to time.

#### Termination of Booking Contract or Change of Travel Arrangements due to Force Majeure

If Golf & Tours in its reasonable opinion, considers that any Force Majeure event prevents Golf & Tours (whether directly or through its employees, contractors, subcontractors and agents) from lawfully or safely providing any products or services subject of the booking contract with you, Golf & Tours may immediately by written notice: (a) terminate the booking contract (in whole or in part); or (b) change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice you for any additional costs.

#### Limitation of Liability in the Event of Force Majeure

In the event of a force majeure event making it impossible or unsafe for Golf & Tours to deliver all or part of the Tour Package, Golf & Tours reserves the rights to postpone the tour to new dates. If these rescheduled dates do not suit the client, Golf & Tours will offer a credit voucher to the full value they have paid for the postponed trip, to be used on a future tour (within 12 months of original tours departure date). Or at Golf & Tours discretion, refund the customer for the unperformed part of the Tour Package less any reasonable losses incurred by cancellation. Losses may amount to a substantial proportion of the tour package price. Golf & Tours will use reasonable endeavours to minimise losses incurred by customers. Customers must take out travel insurance to protect themselves against loss in these circumstances.
