Designed by the acclaimed Bill Coore, the course pays homage to traditional Scottish links, featuring expansive fairways framed by natural heather, gorse, and broom. Among its standout holes is the unforgettable 11th, where a meandering stream cuts across the fairway and hugs the left side up to the back of the green, demanding precision from tee to pin and punishing even the slightest misstep

Every square in the small village centre is packed with history and some incredible architecture. This morning, spend time exploring the gorgeous UNESCO listed city of Bordeaux. The city is filled with classical and neoclassical architecture, and is home to more than 350 structures that are nationally or regionally listed Historical Monuments (Monuments Historiques). Le Miroir d'Eau – the water mirror, is facing the Place de la Bourse, and a beautiful marvel, worthy of a photo or two. Port de la Lune (Port of the Moon) is the nickname given to the crescent-shaped Port of Bordeaux along the Garonne River. Stretching from the Quai de Bacalan to the Quai de Paludate in the centre of the city, the Port of the Moon incorporates the Place de la Bourse and the Quays Market. Lined with quaint boutiques, chic bars and restaurants, it's a beautiful and classy area to wander around.



Afternoon visit to a Bordeaux winery with wine-tasting

A trip to Bordeaux would not be complete without a visit and tasting at a Bordeaux winery. This world-famous wine region is home to some of the oldest and most prestigious wineries in the world.





The designated red grape varieties in Bordeaux are Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Carmenere. Wines from this region set a benchmark for winemakers around the world.

Tonight is yours to do as you like. After the wine tour this afternoon, and your explorations of Bordeaux this morning, you may just feel like finding a little brasserie or bar à vin with trendy stools, cool interiors and fabulous small plates to enjoy.

With its impressive architecture, delicious restaurants and remarkably nice people, there will be time for you to stroll the narrow paved streets of the city centre to absorb the charm of Vieux Cognac (the old Cognac). With almost 200 Cognac producers in the area, we will be enjoying a tasting at Remy Martin, one of the regions most famous cognac houses.



Check In Overnight at Hôtel Le Clos d'Amboise - Standard Room

This is a sumptuous 17th century house converted into a charming hotel in 2003 and upgraded into a 20 room, luxury hotel in 2011, while retaining its character. Everything which speaks of the house's history and gives it its character has been conserved: the floor of the reception hall with its cabochon tiling, the staircase serving the upper floors, and the magnificent 18th century Versailles oak parquet in two salons. Hotel Le Clos d'Amboise is located in the very heart of the Royal City of Amboise, in the picturesque historic part of the city that contains France's first chateau, and Leonardo da Vinci's residence, the Clos Lucé.




Day 6 Thursday 10 September 2026

Les Aisses Golf - 18 Holes of Golf with shared motorised carts



The holes meander amidst the moors, ponds and woods which make the courses varied, enjoyable and challenging.



Check In Overnight at Hôtel Le Littré - Classic Room

In the 6th arr., this truly Parisian, family-run 1920s hotel is poised between the vibrant realms of St Germain des Prés and Montparnasse, and within a 7-minute walk of the Notre-Dame-des-Champs metro station, and a 12-minute walk from the Luxembourg Gardens. The overlooking the hotel's inner courtyard, and promise absolute peace and quiet. High-quality bedding and cozy comforters ensure a peaceful night's sleep.

If, due to supplier availability an item on this itinerary is no longer available for our tour, Golf & Tours reserves the right to substitute the Tour Host, or any of the golf, accommodation, transfers or activities listed in this itinerary with any item of similar standard/value. If, due to Force Majeure event making it impossible or unsafe for Golf & Tours to deliver all or part of the Tour Package, Golf & Tours reserved the rights to postpone the tour to new dates.

By completing our booking form, you have given permission for Golf & Tours to take photographs of yourself, and to publish those photographs for any lawful purpose, including, but not limited to promoting Golf & Tours on their website, social media accounts, and promotional materials, either digital or in print, in perpetuity. If you have a change of heart, you can ask Golf & Tours to stop using your images at any time, in which case efforts will be taken to prevent them being used in future digital and offline publications but they may continue to appear in publications already in circulation.

Flights

This tour requires a minimum number of golfers to proceed. Please do not book your flights until you have been advised by Golf & Tours that this tour will be proceeding. If minimum numbers are not achieved, you will be offered a full refund or opportunity to transfer your payment to another tour.

Revisions, Modifications & Pre/Post Tour Options

Once Golf & Tours has confirmed that the minimum number of guests for a tour has been met, guests are kindly asked to decide if they would like Golf & Tours to arrange extra nights of accommodation before or after the tour, and if their flight schedules do not match the group airport transfers, whether they would prefer a private airport transfer. Golf & Tours is more than willing to organize these additional arrangements for our guests at no extra charge, up until the final balance due date. Any changes made to bookings after this date will incur a \$100 service fee.



Passport & Visas

It is your sole responsibility to ensure you have a valid passport at the time of travelling and that you hold all necessary visas and permits required by the country/countries you will be travelling to. All travellers must hold a passport for international travel, with at least 6 months validity.

In the last quarter of 2026, the rules of travel to most European countries change. Starting in the last quarter of 2026, people from over 60 visa-exempt countries are required to have a travel authorisation to enter 30 European countries for a short stay.

ETIAS travel authorisation is an entry requirement for visa-exempt nationals travelling to any of these 30 European countries. It is linked to a traveller's passport. It is valid for up to three years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. If you get a new passport, you need to get a new ETIAS travel authorisation.

With a valid ETIAS travel authorisation, you can enter the territory of these European countries as often as you want for short-term stays - normally for up to 90 days in any 180-day period.

From 2026, you can fill out the application form using either via the official ETIAS website or the ETIAS mobile application. Applying for the ETIAS travel authorisation costs EUR 7, though some travellers are exempt from paying this fee.

The European Union will inform about the specific date for the start of ETIAS several months prior to its launch.

Travel Insurance

It is mandatory that you have your own comprehensive travel insurance while travelling on a Golf & Tours holiday. The policy should provide cover for any element of your booking including loss of deposit, cancellation, liability for illness, medical expenses, repatriation, personal injury, death or loss of any kind, delay and inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by Golf & Tours or by any other third parties we subcontract to, and loss or damage to baggage and valuables. You are responsible for making any special or increased insurance arrangements which you deem are necessary. The payments made to G&T for your tour are non-refundable. Travel insurance will cover you for unseen circumstances that may force you to withdraw from the tour. Golf & Tours strongly recommends that you take out "Cancel For Any Reason" (CFAR) insurance.

Travel Health

Getting sick overseas is a sure way to ruin your trip. Taking appropriate precautions before beginning your trip can reduce your risk of getting sick whilst overseas. Prevention is better than cure. Your GP or travel doctor can tell you exactly what vaccinations you need for your upcoming trip. Their advice considers your health, your immunisation history and your destination. Golf & Tours recommends speaking to your



doctor, and to consider vaccinating yourself, or getting a booster to protect yourself, against COVID-19 and Influenza.

Staying hydrated is essential when travelling. Worldwide, tap water varies from country to country. Drinking water in other countries is one of the leading causes of health issues for travellers. Travellers become ill because the water pathogens in the local tap water are foreign to their immune systems. At the same time, locals can drink from the same source and have no issue whatsoever because they have adapted to the water supply from a very early age. Golf & Tours recommends drinking bottle water, and using bottled water to brush your teeth on any tour, outside of your home country.

Pricing

Every effort is made to ensure that the prices quoted to you are correct; however, Golf & Tours Pty Ltd acts only as an agent and relies on information provided to us from our suppliers of the travel services and products listed in this itinerary. We will bring to your attention any change in price prior to you paying the balance of the tour. N.B some golf clubs, hotels, transfer companies and travel service providers reserve the right to increase their pricing due to increases in green fees, hotel accommodation charges and currency fluctuations etc. Where the increase in price is greater than 10% of the original price of the tour, you may choose to either:

- (a) cancel the applicable booking without incurring any penalty; or
- (b) accept the change of price

You must notify the Golf & Tours of your choice within 14 days of receipt of notice of the increase or you will be deemed to have accepted the price change and will be liable for payment of the increase.

Payments

Golf & Tours accepts the following payment methods: Direct bank deposits, Wire Transfers and Credit Cards (Visa, American Express or MasterCard N.B credit card payments will incur a 2.9% processing fee for Australian Cards and a 3.9% processing fee for any non-Australian Credit Cards.

A **EUR3,000 per person deposit** is required to secure your place on this tour. After you have confirmed your booking, we will contact you so you can make this payment.

A further **EUR2,000pp progress payment** will be due on the **2nd February 2026** with the final balance due on **7th June 2026**. Golf & Tours will contact you, advising of the full amount owing for the tour, minus the deposits already paid, giving you the final balance owing, on this date.

This tour has been priced in Euro (EUR). At the time of booking, you will be able to choose the currency that you wish to make all of your payments in. The deposit amount below, will be in your chosen currency.

Eg. If you chose USD, your deposit will be USD3,000pp, your progress payment will be USD2,000pp & the balance in USD. If you chose AUD as your chosen currency, your deposit will be AUD3,000pp, your progress payment will be AUD2,000pp & the balance in AUD.



Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellations by the client must be in writing and are subject to the following forfeit of cost per person:

- Cancellation before final balance payment is required: Deposit lost
- Cancellation after final balance payment has been completed: 100% of the tour cost charged

If the company is forced to cancel a tour due to minimum numbers not being reached, a full refund or option to transfer full deposit to a subsequent tour will be offered to the client. This does not include Force Majeure.

Force Majeure

Force Majeure means the occurrence of an event that is beyond Golf & Tours' reasonable control and which could not have been reasonably prevented by Golf & Tours which includes, but is not limited to: (a) war, armed conflict, criminal damage, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity or the threat of any such acts; (b) natural disaster (including but not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide, pandemic), adverse weather conditions, high or low water levels; (c) nuclear or other industrial accident causing environmental pollution or contamination; or (d) change in law, meaning, enactment, amendment (including repeal) in the law or administration of any law in Australia or any jurisdiction or territory relevant to the booking contract, which includes changes in statute, regulation, determination, by-law, declaration, licence and the common law as applicable from time to time.

Termination of Booking Contract or Change of Travel Arrangements due to Force Majeure

If Golf & Tours in its reasonable opinion, considers that any Force Majeure event prevents Golf & Tours (whether directly or through its employees, contractors, subcontractors and agents) from lawfully or safely providing any products or services subject of the booking contract with you, Golf & Tours may immediately by written notice: (a) terminate the booking contract (in whole or in part); or (b) change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice you for any additional costs.

Limitation of Liability in the Event of Force Majeure

In the event of a force majeure event making it impossible or unsafe for Golf & Tours to deliver all or part of the Tour Package, Golf & Tours reserves the rights to postpone the tour to new dates. If these rescheduled dates do not suit the client, Golf & Tours will offer a credit voucher to the full value they have paid for the postponed trip, to be used on a future tour (within 12 months of original tours departure date). Or at Golf & Tours discretion, refund the customer for the unperformed part of the Tour Package less any reasonable losses incurred by cancellation. Losses may amount to a substantial proportion of the tour package price. Golf & Tours will use reasonable endeavours to minimise losses incurred by customers. Customers must take out travel insurance to protect themselves against loss in these circumstances.
