Ranked #5 in Morocco**

Nestled amidst the picturesque setting of the snow-capped Atlas Mountains, Assoufid Golf Club features a, par-72 course that winds through a distinctive desert landscape with natural undulations. The par four 5th is one of the toughest holes on the card. Played from an elevated tee, its fairway is flanked on either side by desert as it rises directly towards the Atlas Mountains. The tee for the par three 17th is located at the highest point on the course – offering panoramic views of all the holes on the back nine – and it's the starting point for the signature hole at Assoufid. Tee shots must carry a natural dry stream (called a shaaba) that runs through the course before reaching a wide but shallow green protected by bunkers to the front and rear.

## Revisions, Modifications & Pre/Post Tour Options and Fees

Once Golf & Tours has confirmed that the minimum number of guests for a tour has been met, guests are kindly asked to decide if they would like Golf & Tours to arrange extra nights of accommodation before or after the tour, and if their flight schedules do not match the group airport transfers, whether they would prefer (for an additional cost) a private airport transfer. Golf & Tours is more than willing to organise these additional arrangements for our guests at no extra charge, up until the final balance due date. Any changes made to bookings after this date will incur a \$100 service fee, which will be charged in your booked currency.

## Passport & Visas

It is your sole responsibility to ensure you have a valid passport at the time of travelling and that you hold all necessary visas and permits required by the country/countries you will be travelling to. All travellers



must hold a passport for international travel, with at least 6 months validity as at the completion date of the tour.

## Travel Insurance

It is mandatory that you have your own comprehensive travel insurance while travelling on a Golf & Tours holiday. The policy should provide cover for any element of your booking including loss of deposit, cancellation, liability for illness, medical expenses, repatriation, personal injury, death or loss of any kind, delay and inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by Golf & Tours or by any other third parties we subcontract to, and loss or damage to baggage and valuables. You are responsible for making any special or increased insurance arrangements which you deem are necessary. The payments made to Golf & Tours for your tour are non-refundable. Travel insurance will cover you for unseen circumstances that may force you to withdraw from the tour. Golf & Tours strongly recommends that you take out "Cancel For Any Reason" (CFAR) insurance.

Golf & Tours is not responsible for any gaps, exclusions, or deficiencies in your insurance policy.

## Pricing

We reserve the right to modify or substitute any activity or Services at any time at our sole discretion, including for safety, local conditions, weather, operational reasons, or unforeseen events. We may update you upon making any such changes. Where necessary, equivalent substitutions will be provided and you will be notified of any significant changes at the earliest opportunity.

You agree that Golf & Tours acts as agent and relies on pricing provided by its suppliers. If there is any change to the tour price, you will be notified in writing prior to payment of the final balance.

Suppliers may increase prices due to changes in green fees, accommodation costs, currency movements, fuel surcharges or other operational expenses. If any such increase exceeds 10% of the original total tour price, you may, within 14 days of receiving written notice of the increase:

- (i) cancel the Booking and receive a full refund of all amounts paid; or
- (ii) accept the revised price.

If you do not notify Golf & Tours of your election within that 14-day period, you will be deemed to have accepted the revised price.

## Payments

Golf & Tours accepts the following payment methods: Direct bank deposits, Wire Transfers and Credit Cards (Visa, American Express or MasterCard N.B credit card payments will incur a 2.9% processing fee for Australian Cards and a 3.9% processing fee for any non-Australian Credit Cards.

A **\$3000 per person deposit** is required to secure your place on this tour. After you have confirmed your booking, we will contact you so you can make this payment.



A further **\$3000 per person deposit/progress payment** will be due on the **13<sup>th</sup> September 2026**, with the final balance due on **1<sup>st</sup> December 2026**. Golf & Tours will contact you, advising of the full amount owing for the tour, minus the deposits already paid, giving you the final balance owing.

This tour has been priced in Euro (EUR). At the time of booking, you will be able to choose the currency that you wish to make all of your payments in.

The deposit amount will be in your chosen currency. Eg. If you chose USD, your deposit will be USD\$3000pp and any additional deposits and the balance in USD. If you chose Australian Dollar (AUD) as your chosen currency, your deposit will be AUD\$3000pp and any additional deposits and the balance in AUD.

## Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellations by the client must be in writing and are subject to the following forfeit of cost per person:

- Cancellation before final balance payment is required: All payments lost
- Cancellation after final balance payment has been completed: 100% of the tour cost charged

If the company is forced to cancel a tour due to minimum numbers not being reached, a full refund or option to transfer full deposit to a subsequent tour will be offered to the client. This does not include Force Majeure.

## Force Majeure

Force Majeure means the occurrence of an event that is beyond Golf & Tours' reasonable control and which could not have been reasonably prevented by Golf & Tours which includes, but is not limited to: (a) war, armed conflict, criminal damage, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity or the threat of any such acts; (b) natural disaster (including but not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide, pandemic), adverse weather conditions, high or low water levels; (c) nuclear or other industrial accident causing environmental pollution or contamination; or (d) change in law, meaning, enactment, amendment (including repeal) in the law or administration of any law in Australia or any jurisdiction or territory relevant to the booking contract, which includes changes in statute, regulation, determination, by-law, declaration, licence and the common law as applicable from time to time.



In the event of a force majeure event making it impossible or unsafe for Golf & Tours to deliver all or part of the Tour Package, Golf & Tours reserves the rights to postpone the tour to new dates. If these rescheduled dates do not suit the client, Golf & Tours will offer a credit voucher to the full value they have paid for the postponed trip, to be used on a future tour (within 12 months of original tours departure date). Or at Golf & Tours discretion, refund the customer for the unperformed part of the Tour Package less any reasonable losses incurred by cancellation.
