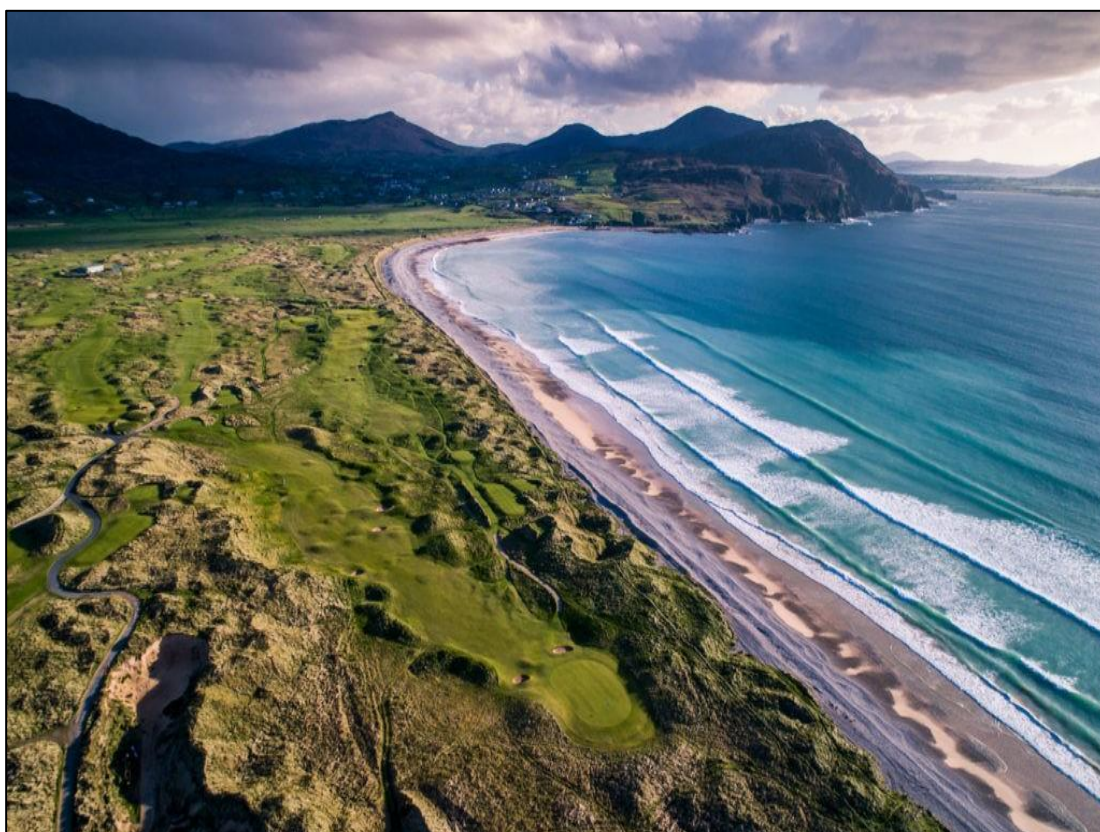

Ballyliffin Golf Club - Old Course - 18 Holes with Shared Motorised Carts

Ranked #21 in Ireland

The Old course at Ballyliffin Golf Club is a classic links, with fairways that pitch and roll through wild dunes. This is links golf at its most traditional, and one that Nick Faldo called "One of the most natural courses I have ever played". There are many memorable holes on the Old course, but the 190-yard par three 5th, called "The Tank", will stick in the mind for a very long time. It's an intimidating tee shot to an elevated plateau, almost stage-like green that is surrounded by dunes.

Ballyliffin Golf Club - Glashedy Links - 18 Holes with Shared Motorised Carts

Ranked #13 in Ireland

Ballyliffin Golf Club is often described as “the Ballybunion of the North” or “the Dornoch of Ireland” and there's a parallel here to the fairways of Royal Birkdale. Glashedy Links is a championship links course, host to major tournaments, offering a pure test of golf in a stunning coastal setting on the edge of the Wild Atlantic Way. The holes weave their way through the wild dunes. It's a supremely challenging golf course which stretches out more than 7,200 yards, with nine brutal par fours in excess of 400 yards.

Walking Tour of Derry/Londonderry with Local Guide

Today offers a deeply moving and meaningful insight into the history and resilience of Northern Ireland as we join a local guide for a walking tour through Derry/Londonderry's Bogside district. Led by someone personally connected to the events of Bloody Sunday and actively involved in the long journey toward justice and peace, this experience provides a powerful and authentic perspective on the Civil Rights era, the Battle of the Bogside, the famous Bogside Murals and the Peace Process. Following the tour, guests will have free time to explore the historic walled city of Derry/Londonderry at their own pace.

Rosapenna - Sandy Hills Links - 18 Holes with Shared Motorised Carts

Ranked #22 in Ireland

Running up and through some of the most breathtaking dunes in Ireland, Sandy Hills offers some of the most remarkable scenery at Rosapenna, with stunning views of both the Old Tom Morris Links and Sheephaven Bay that will have you reaching for your camera regularly. Golf at Rosapenna dates back to 1891, when Old Tom Morris set out the original holes on the Old Tom Morris course. Right from the 1st, you are in a spectacular landscape, among gigantic dunes. Going over and through the dunes provides a platform to drink in the stunning views across the Old course to Sheephaven Bay beyond.

Ranked #37 in the World

By creating a single 18-hole course on a site big enough for two, designer Tom Doak's inspired routing has few rivals, creating dramatic reveals through massive dunes, sandy blowouts and the nearby Atlantic. St Patrick's is playable, walkable and so much fun. The scale of St. Patrick's Links is hard to capture in photographs, let alone with words. Everything, from the fairways and greens to the bunkers and dunes, is bigger and bolder than any description can do justice. The same is true of the spellbinding views found at numerous points throughout the course. Some holes are routed through the enormous dunes and feel rather secluded. Others meander up and over the terrain, showcasing the grand scale and setting of the course.

Cruit Island Golf Club - 9 Holes with Pull Trollies

(N.B motorised carts may be available for golfers who have a medical certificate)

Ranked #51 in Ireland

Cruit Island Golf Club is considered by some to be one of the best 9-hole golf courses in the world. It is certainly one of the most scenic courses in Ireland. Overlooking Arranmore and Owey Islands and with Mount Errigal as a backdrop, Cruit is tucked away in this north west corner of County Donegal and is about as far off the beaten track as you can get when searching for a "hidden gem" course. Cruit Island is 2,809 yards long with seven par fours and two par threes, one of which, the 150-yard 6th, is the spectacular signature hole, played along the cliff edge. The first two holes are stiff openers, both measuring over four hundred yards in length and the other par three is no pushover at 213 yards.



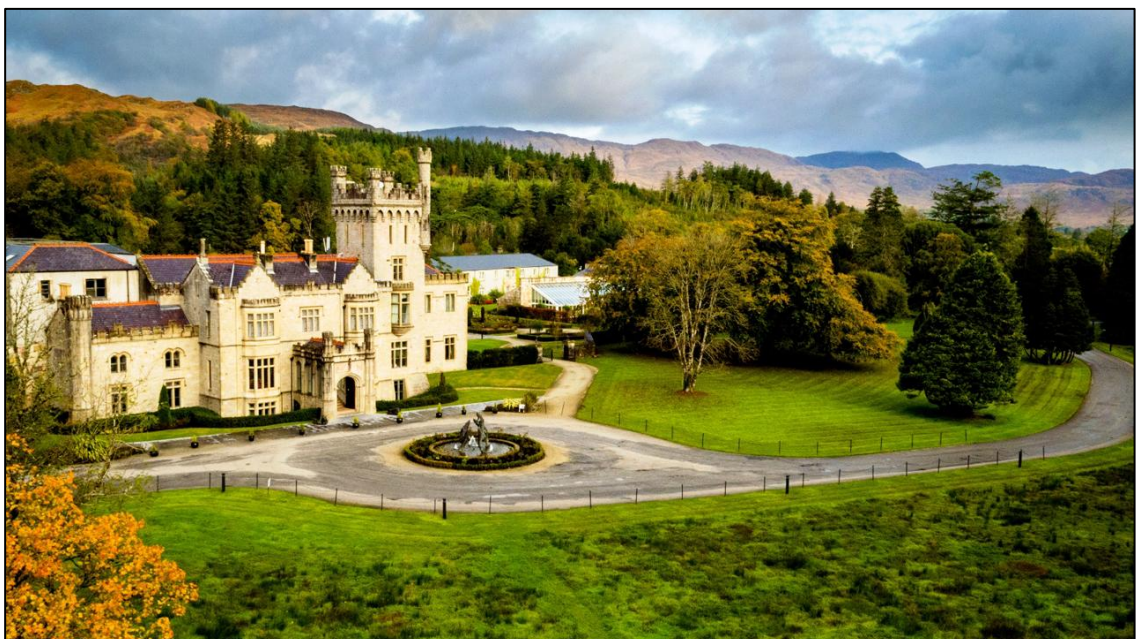
Lunch in the fishing village of Burtonport

Following golf at the wonderfully unique Cruit Island Golf Club, you'll enjoy a relaxed lunch at The Lobster Pot in the nearby fishing village of Burtonport. Known for its warm Donegal hospitality and fresh local seafood, this authentic coastal stop offers the perfect opportunity to unwind over hearty chowder, locally caught seafood and a pint while soaking in the charm and atmosphere of Ireland's rugged northwest coast.



Check In: **Lough Eske Castle** - Courtyard Room – 5 Star

The 5 star Lough Eske Castle is an award-winning hotel with a long history which is wrapped in the story of Co. Donegal and Ireland. Each room complements the restoration of the historic castle, sensitive to the heritage and location, they each take inspiration from it, resulting in superior castle accommodation in Ireland. The charming country-house style Courtyard Rooms open directly into the hotel gardens. are set in the original castle stables dating back to the 1600s and are accessible from outside the main hotel building.

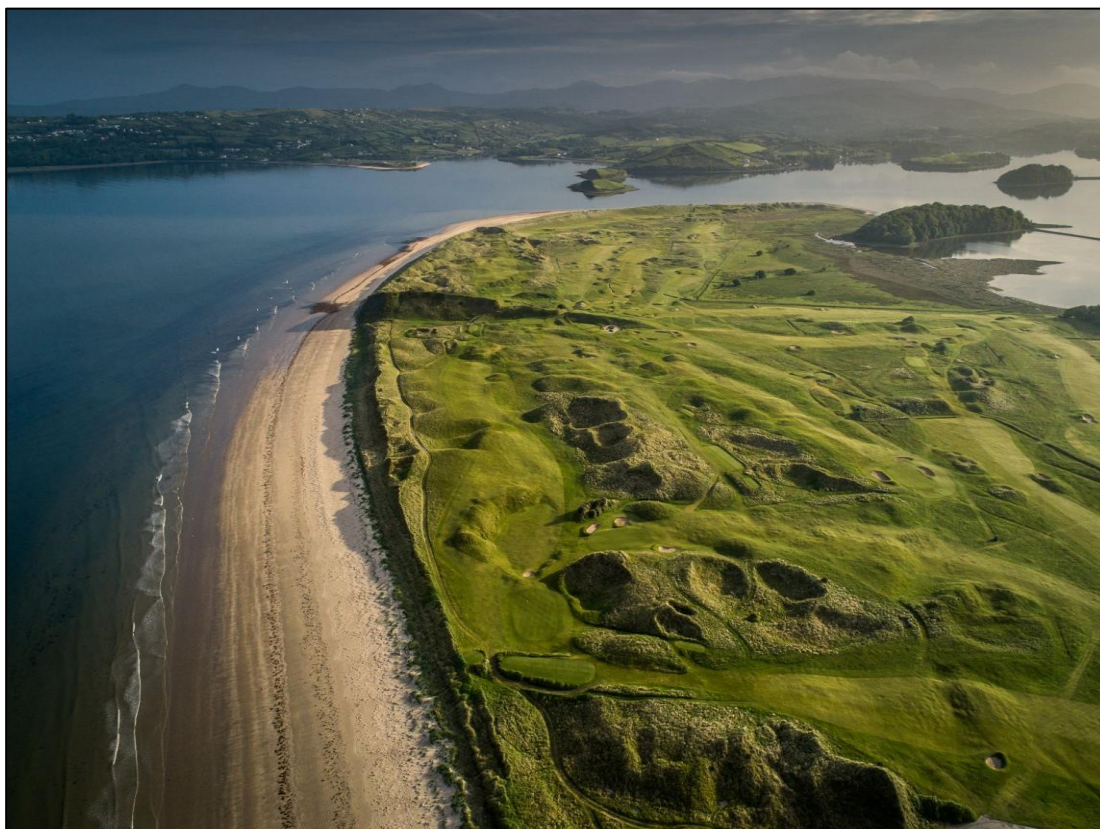

Donegal Golf Club - 18 Holes with Shared Motorised Carts

Ranked #24 in Ireland

One of Darren Clarke's "favourite courses in the world", Donegal Golf Club is located on the Murvagh peninsula jutting out into Donegal Bay. Donegal's layout is configured in two elongated loops of nine holes. The front nine runs anticlockwise and the back nine runs clockwise, sitting inside the outward nine. From the 185-yard par three 5th, we enter dune country. This one shot hole, called "Valley of Tears", is a brute. A semi-blind tee shot to a narrow plateau green, we must make sure that we select the right club to traverse the valley and the bunkers in front of and below the raised green. The next three holes are stunning where the fairways rollercoaster up and down, flanked by huge shaggy sand dunes. At the turn, we are faced with a thrilling back nine, including the 12th, a monster par five, and the sadistic par three 16th, measuring nigh on 250 yards from the back tees.

Narin and Portnoo Links - 18 Holes with Shared Motorised Carts

Ranked #19 in Ireland

Narin & Portnoo is a classic Irish links set on a breathtaking strip of land on the Donegal coast in the north-west of the country. This is old-fashioned, unpretentious links golf. On the edge of the Wild Atlantic Way, the course has a wild and thrillingly unkempt look, with heaving dunes, wild grasses, and both a rocky coast and a sandy beach. The course has ample elevation and juts out into a peninsula feeding down to stunning views of Gweebarra Bay.

Any changes made to bookings after this date will incur a \$100 service fee, which will be charged in your booked currency.

Passport & Visas

It is your sole responsibility to ensure you have a valid passport at the time of travelling and that you hold all necessary visas and permits required by the country/countries you will be travelling to. All travellers must hold a passport for international travel, with at least 6 months validity as at the completion date of the tour.

Travel Insurance

It is mandatory that you have your own comprehensive travel insurance while travelling on a Golf & Tours holiday. Pricing

We reserve the right to modify or substitute any activity or Services at any time at our sole discretion, including for safety, local conditions, weather, operational reasons, or unforeseen events. We may update you upon making any such changes. Where necessary, equivalent substitutions will be provided and you will be notified of any significant changes at the earliest opportunity.

You agree that Golf & Tours acts as agent and relies on pricing provided by its suppliers. If there is any change to the tour price, you will be notified in writing prior to payment of the final balance.

Suppliers may increase prices due to changes in green fees, accommodation costs, currency movements, fuel surcharges or other operational expenses. If any such increase exceeds 10% of the original total tour price, you may, within 14 days of receiving written notice of the increase:

- (i) cancel the Booking and receive a full refund of all amounts paid; or
- (ii) accept the revised price.

If you do not notify Golf & Tours of your election within that 14-day period, you will be deemed to have accepted the revised price.

Payments

Golf & Tours accepts the following payment methods: Direct bank deposits, Wire Transfers and Credit Cards (Visa, American Express or MasterCard N.B credit card payments will incur a 2.9% processing fee for Australian Cards and a 3.9% processing fee for any non-Australian Credit Cards.

This tour has been priced in Euro (EUR). At the time of booking, you will be able to choose the currency that you wish to make all of your payments in.

The deposit/payment amount, will be in your chosen currency. Eg. If you chose USD, your deposit will be USD\$3,000pp and any additional deposit/payments and the balance in USD. If you chose Australian Dollar (AUD) as your chosen currency, your deposit will be AUD3,000pp and any additional deposit/payments and the balance in AUD.

A **\$3,000 per person deposit** is required to secure your place on this tour. After you have confirmed your booking, we will contact you so you can make this payment.

A further **\$3,000 per person deposit/progress payment** will be due on **25th March 2027**, with the final balance due on **23rd June 2027**. Golf & Tours will contact you, advising of the full amount owing for the tour, minus the deposit/payments already paid, giving you the final balance owing.

Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellations by the client must be in writing and are subject to the following forfeit of cost per person:

- Cancellation before final balance payment is required: All payments lost

- Cancellation after final balance payment has been completed: 100% of the tour cost charged

If the company is forced to cancel a tour due to minimum numbers not being reached, a full refund or option to transfer full deposit to a subsequent tour will be offered to the client. This does not include Force Majeure.

Conduct & Behaviour
